REC 16-hour Outdoor First Aid Course - £150

A two-day course (16 hours). The Outdoor First Aid Course is designed to introduce a systematic way of first aid for managing casualties. Topic learning and practicals intermixed with scenarios of real situations.

The course includes:

- The fundamental workings of the body, in particular the heart, lungs and airway.
- Assessing a casualty.
- Introduces a system to cope with all incidents as safely as possible.
- Deciding how to deal with an accident or incident.
- Awareness of delayed medical help and adverse environmental conditions.
